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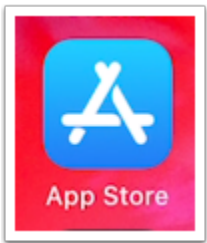
## General Information

## How do I download the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device?

Download the Canvas Parent app on your iOS device to engage in your child's education.

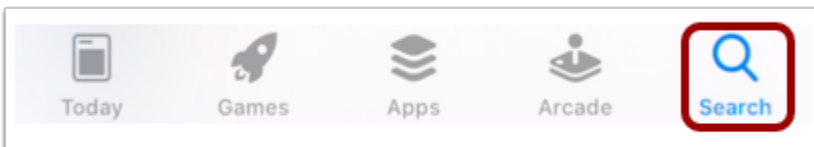
The images in this lesson are shown for a phone display, but unless otherwise noted, tablet displays mirror the same steps.

### Open App Store



Open your iOS device and tap the **App Store** icon.

### Open Search



In phone devices, tap the **Search** icon at the bottom of the screen.

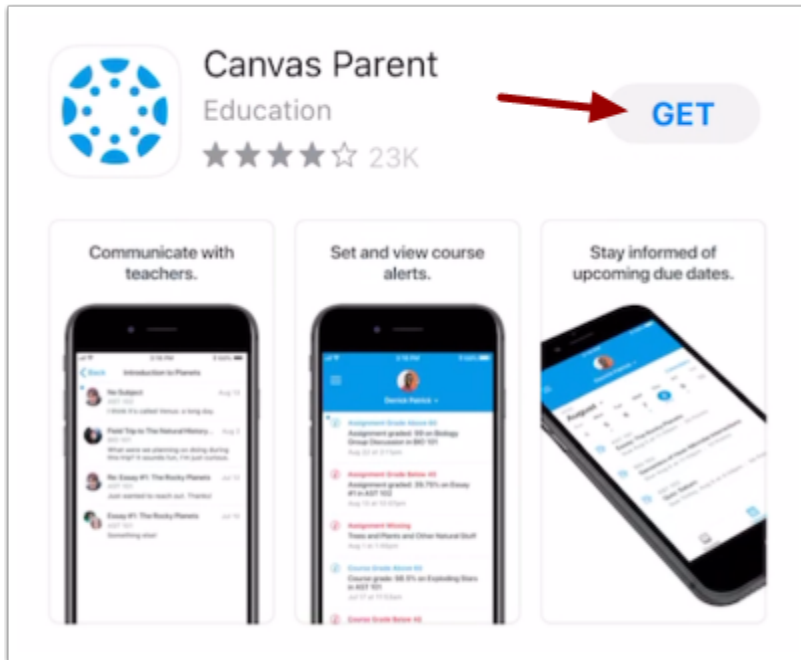
In tablet devices, tap the **Search** field at the top of the App Store.

### Search for App



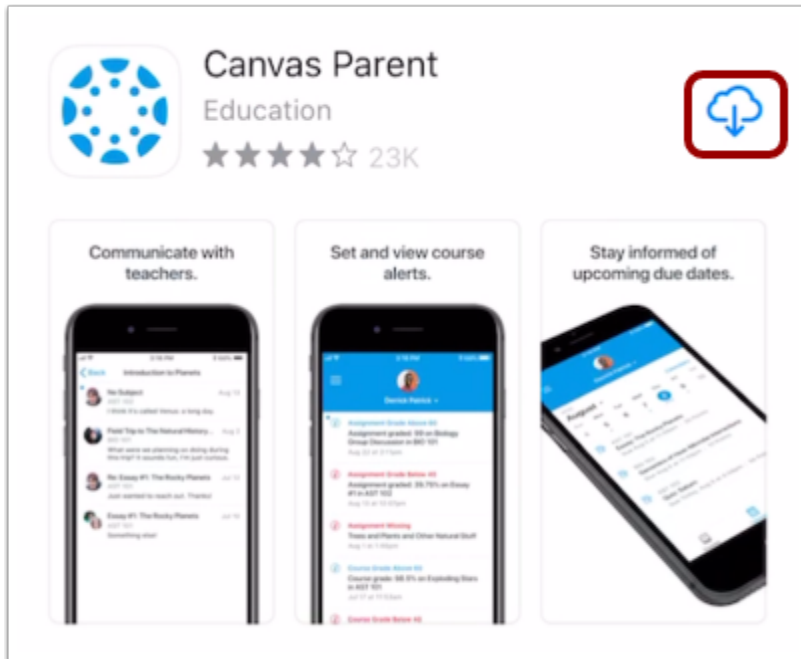
In the search field, type Canvas Parent in the search field. Tap the full name when it appears.

## Select App



Tap the **Get** button.

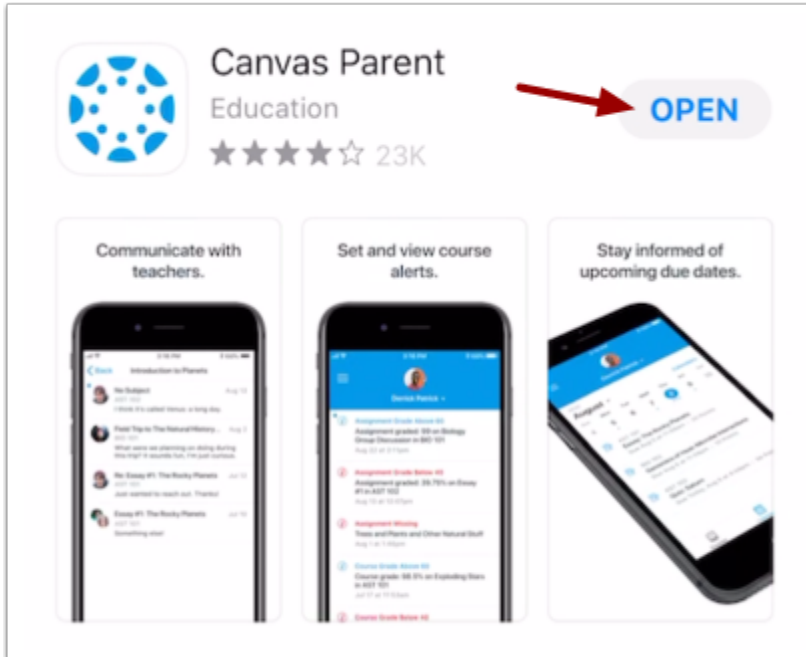
## Install App



Tap the **Install** button.

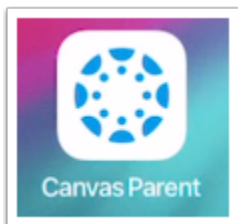
**Note:** The App Store may ask for your App Store password to download the app.

## Open App



When the app has downloaded and installed onto your iOS device, you can access the app immediately by tapping the **Open** button.

## View App on iOS Home Screen



You can also open the app on your iOS home screen by tapping the **Canvas Parent** icon.



## How do I create an account in the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device?

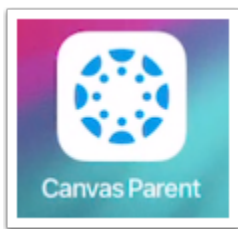
In the Canvas Parent app, you can create a Canvas observer account to view student course information. If you already have an account, you can [log in to the Parent app](#).

To link yourself to a student, you will need to enter a student-specific pairing code that will link you to the student. Pairing codes are valid for seven days. Students can [generate pairing codes](#) from their User Settings. Depending on institution permissions, admins and instructors may also be able to generate pairing codes.

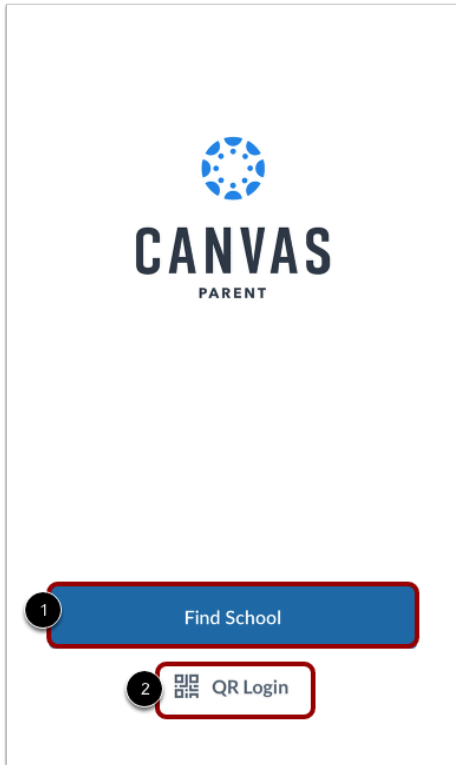
**Note:** If you are not able to create an account, your school has not enabled self-registration. Please contact your school to create your account.

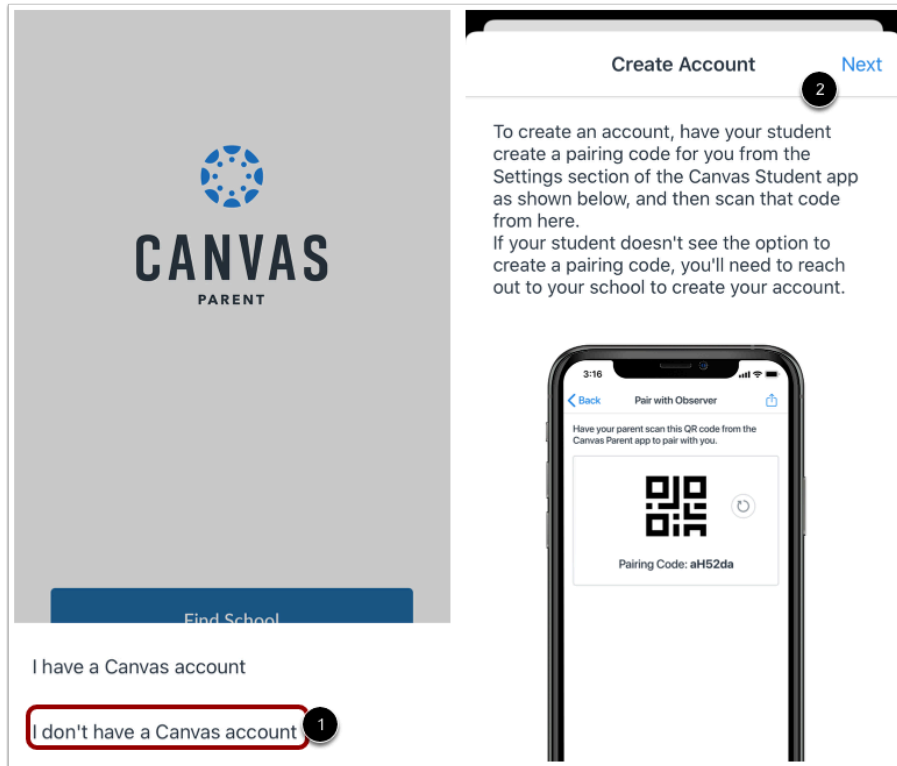


To find your institution, tap the **Find School** button [1]. To create an account using a generated pairing QR code, tap the **QR Code** link [2].

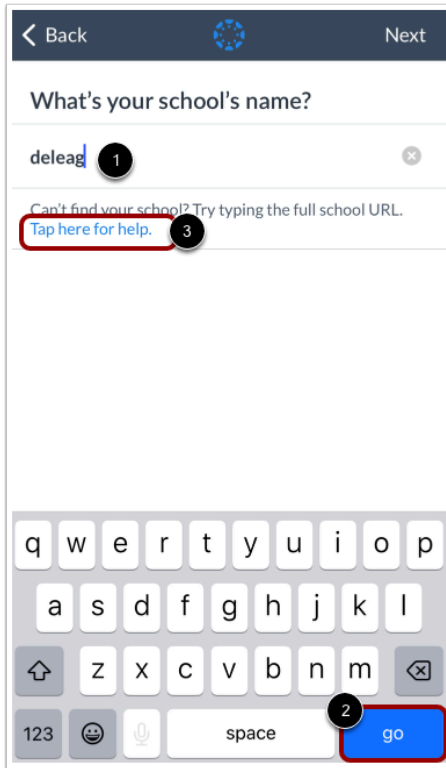
## Find Institution

**Note:** If you are an admin and your school does not appear in the search list, please contact your CSM about mobile smart search.


## Enter Canvas URL

## How do I log in to the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device with a Canvas URL?

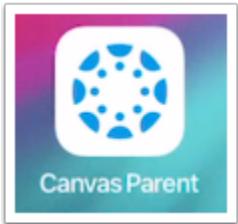
Once you [download the Canvas Parent app](#) from the iTunes store, you can use the app to log in to your Canvas account.

You can enter your institution's name into the app to locate your account. If the app cannot find your institution by name, you can enter your institution's Canvas URL into the app. If you don't know your Canvas URL, you can [log in using a QR code](#), which does not require knowing your Canvas URL for the mobile app.

If you do not want to locate your Canvas URL every time you log in to Canvas, learn how to [switch to another user account](#).

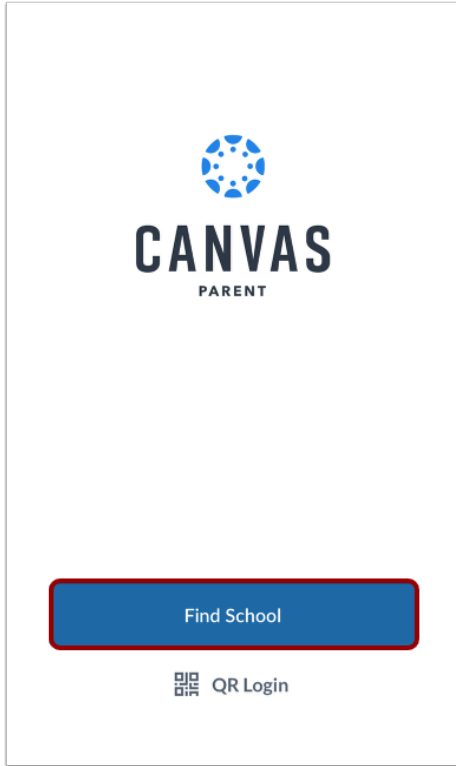




## Search for Institution Name



Enter the name of your institution or school district. If the full name appears in the search list, tap the name.

**Note:** If you are an admin and your school does not appear in the search list, please contact your CSM about mobile smart search.

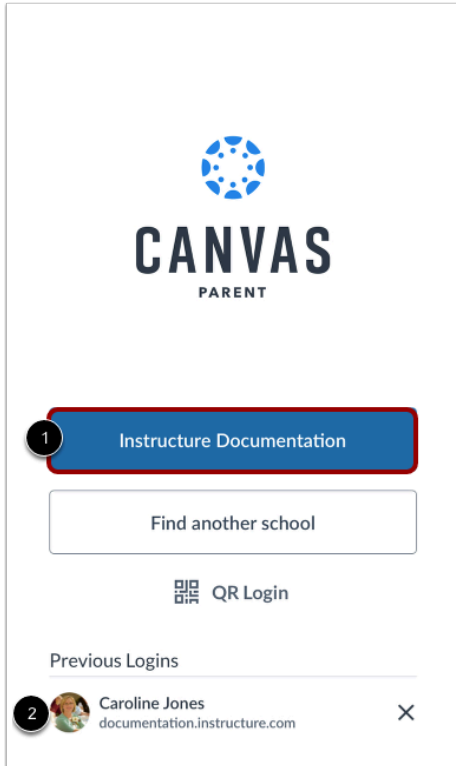
## Enter Canvas URL



If the name of your institution does not appear in the search list, you may need to locate your Canvas account by entering the full Canvas URL in the *Find your school or district* text field.

If you don't know your Canvas URL, tap the **Tap Here for Help** link. Or you can [log in using a QR code](#), which does not require knowing your Canvas URL.


## View Previous Canvas URL



If you previously logged into the app, your Canvas URL displays. To log in again, tap the Canvas URL button [1].

If you previously changed users in the app, to log in again, you can tap the user's account [2].

## Enter Login Credentials


After you've located an account, you can view the Canvas URL at the top of the screen [1]. Enter your email [2] and password [3]. Tap the **Log In** button [4].

If you don't know your password, tap the **Forgot Password?** link [5].

### Notes:

- The Canvas email field credential varies according to institution. Some institutions may require a username or account number.
- If your Canvas mobile login page does not show the reset password option, contact your institution if you need to reset your password.
- If your institution requires you to log in to Canvas using their authentication system, you will be redirected to your institution's login page.

## How do I log in to the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device with a QR code?

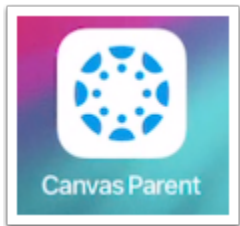
Once you [download the Canvas Parent app](#) from the iTunes store, you can use the app to log in to your Canvas account.

You can generate a unique QR code from your Canvas web browser to quickly log into the app. This method uses your credentials from the QR code to log you into the app. The QR code is located in your account profile (User Navigation Menu).

If you do not want to locate your Canvas URL every time you log in to Canvas, learn how to [switch to another user account](#).

In the Canvas Parent app, you can log in with Canvas observer credentials to view student course information. If you do not have a Canvas account, you can [create an account in the Parent app](#).

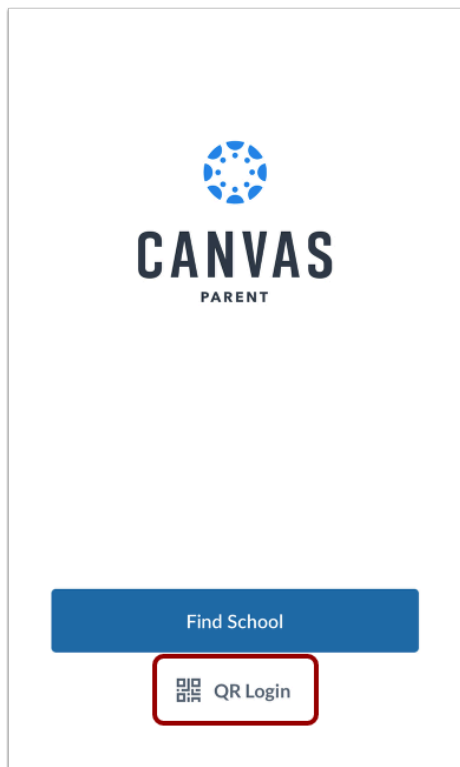

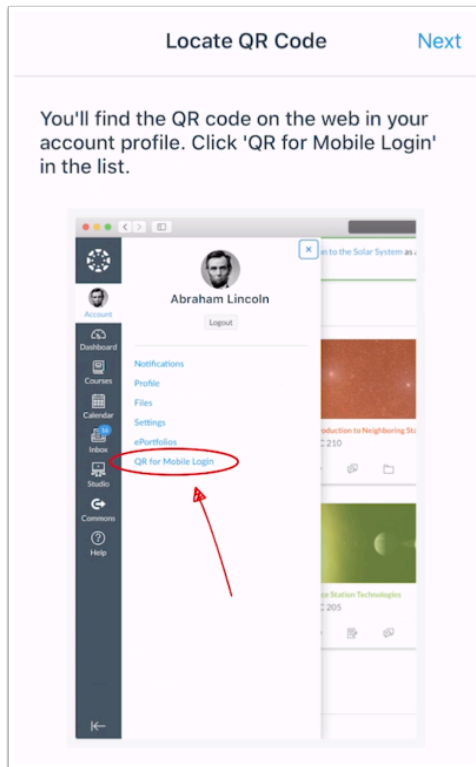


## Open QR Login



Tap the **QR Login** link.

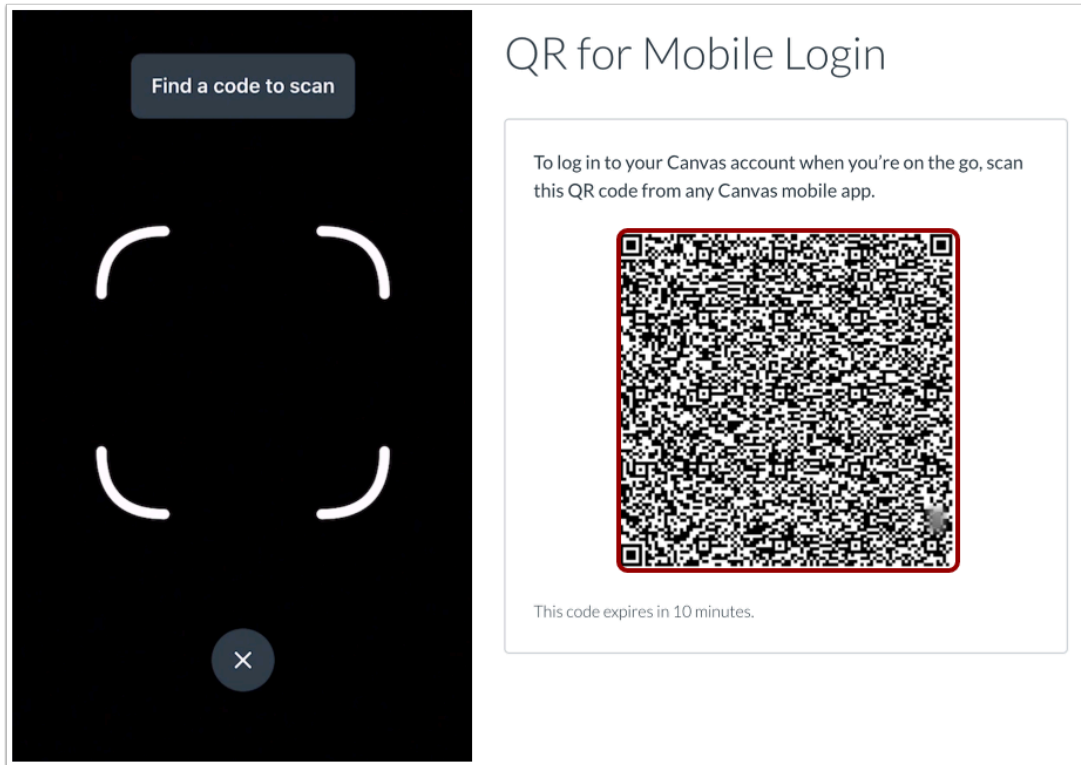
## View Instructions



Review the instructions for locating the QR code in the web version of Canvas. The QR code is located in your account profile (User Navigation Menu).

When you have located the QR code, click the **Next** button.

## Scan QR Code

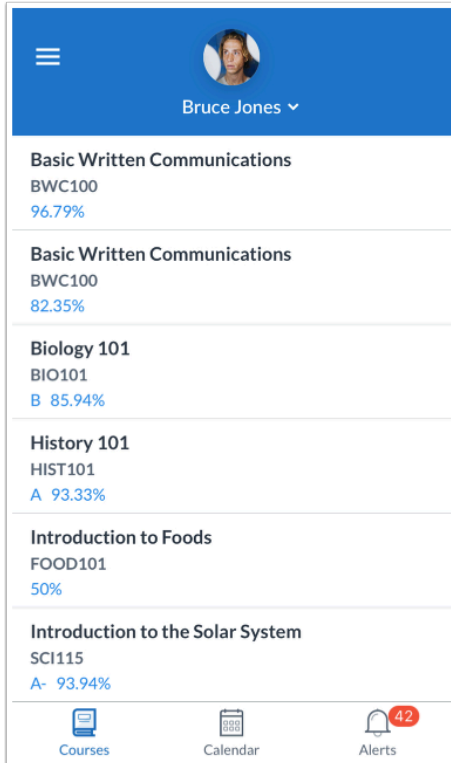


Hold your phone up to your computer screen to scan the QR code. Once the code is located, the app will update automatically.

### Notes:

- You may have to grant permission for your phone to use your camera.
- The app may take a few minutes to log you in.

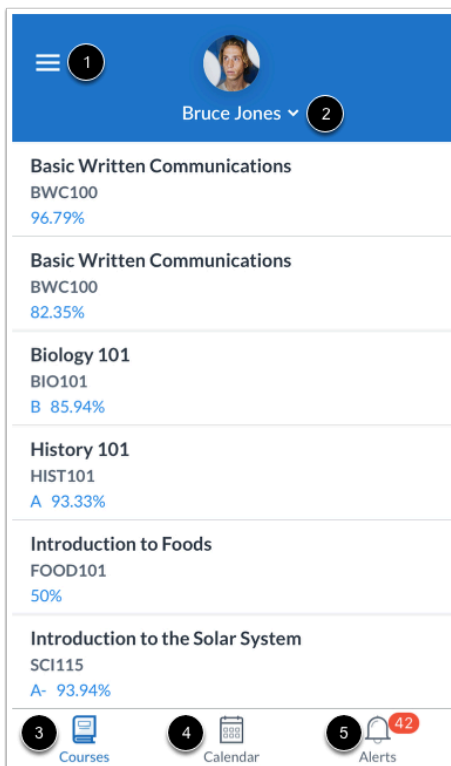
## How do I use the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device?

The Canvas Parent app lets you view a student's course events, upcoming assignments, and grades. You can also add and view multiple students in your account.

### Notes:

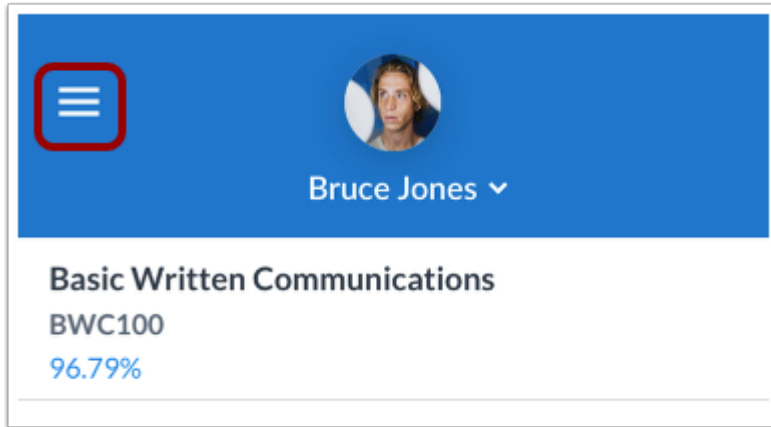
- The Canvas Parent app uses your device's settings to set the time zone used within the app.
- When creating an account, you can link one observed student in the Parent app. Learn how to [link additional students](#) in the Parent app.
- You cannot remove observed students in the Parent app.
- To change the language displayed in the Parent app, select a language in Canvas from a web browser, log out of the Parent app, and log in again.

## View Parent App



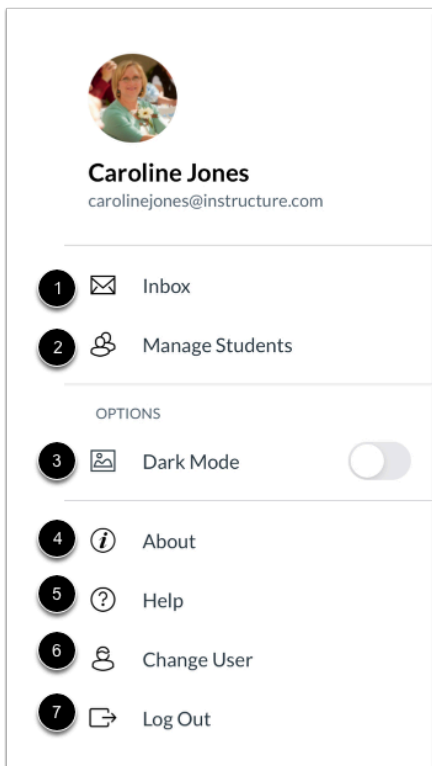
In the Canvas Parent app, you can view your User Menu [1], select a student [2], and view the student's courses [3], the student's weekly calendar [4], and alerts about the student's course participation [5].

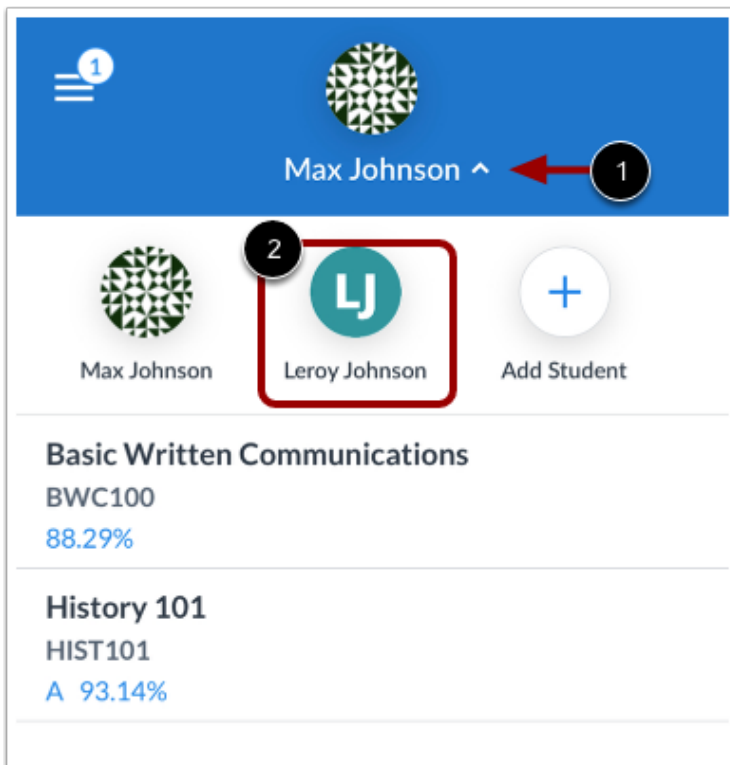

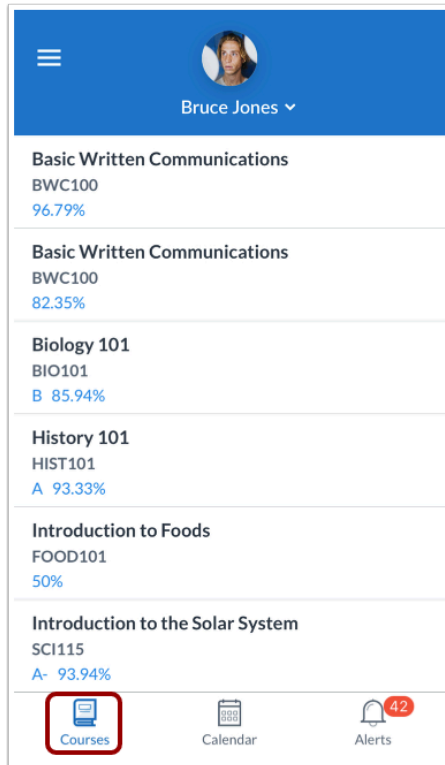
## View Student



Your student's name and profile picture display in the Parent app. To view additional students associated with your account, tap the **Student Selector** [1]. Then tap the name of the student [2].

**Note:** Student profile pictures only display if the student's institution allows students to upload profile pictures.

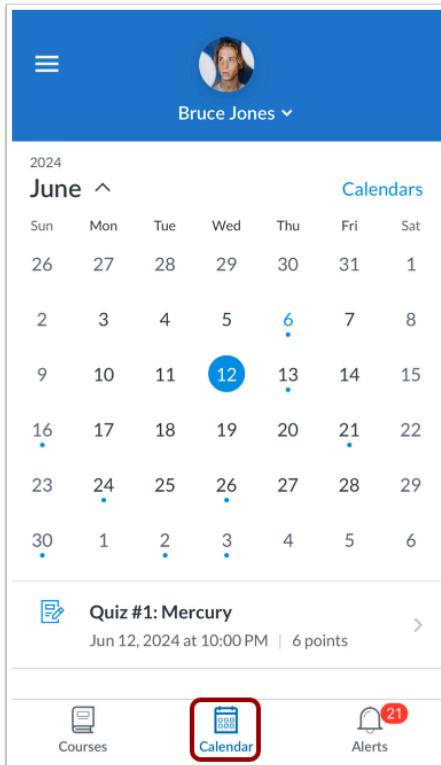
## View Courses



The Parent app defaults to the Courses page and displays the list of courses for the student you are viewing. Learn how to [view courses](#).

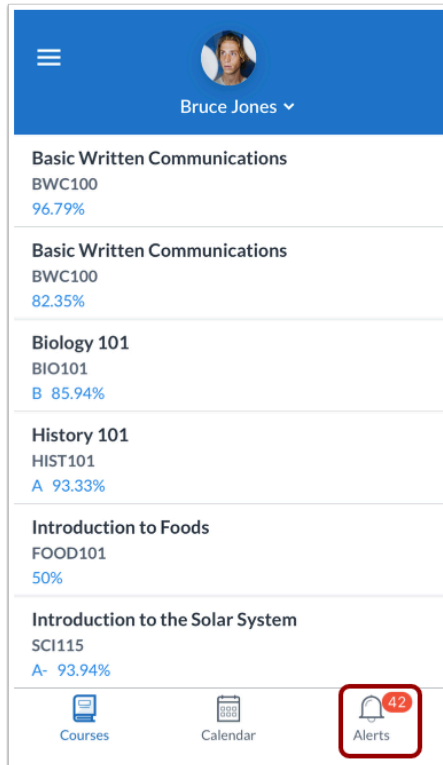


## View Calendar



The Calendar page displays a calendar of assignments and events for a given week. Learn how to [view the calendar](#).

## View Alerts



The Alerts page displays grade and assignment alerts. Learn how to [view alerts](#).

**Note:** The Parent app displays assignment details and grades. Student assignment submissions can only be viewed in a Canvas browser.

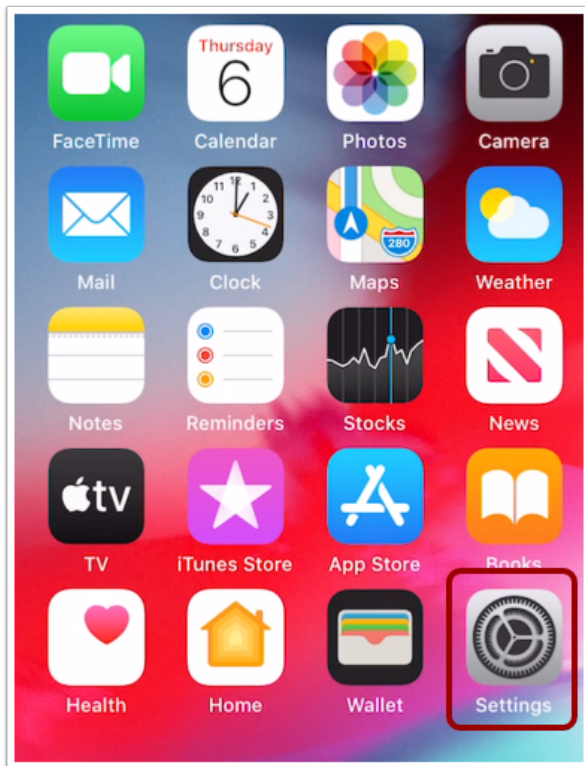
## How do I reset my cache in the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device?

You can reset your cache in the Canvas Parent app on your iOS device. Resetting your cache will clear all information on your device that is specific to the app, including login details and app settings.

You may want to use a cache reset if you experience errors when logging in to the app. Because a cache reset will remove app information from your device, you may want to try resetting your password or uninstalling the app first.

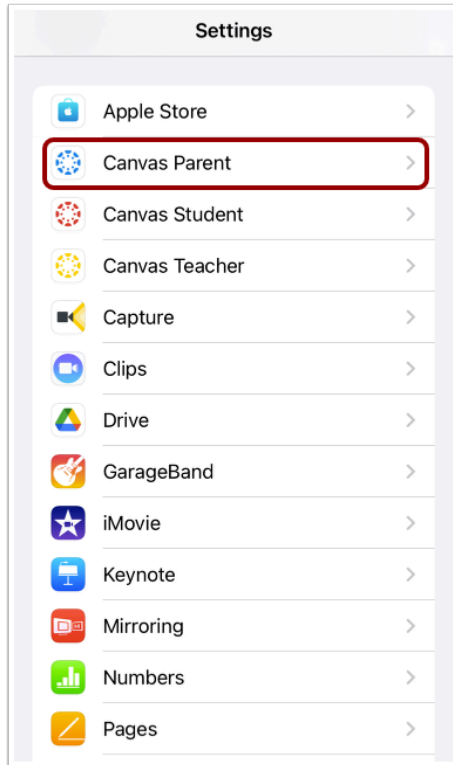
After enabling the Reset Cache on Next Launch option, you must force close and relaunch the Parent app for your cache to reset.

### Open Settings



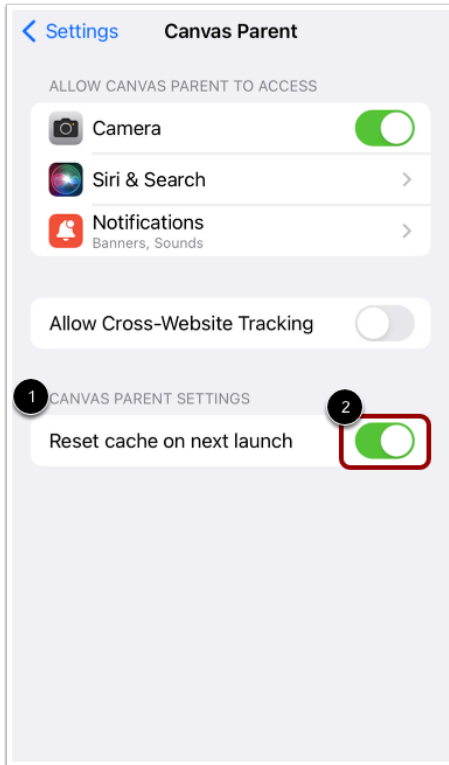
On the home screen, tap the **Settings** icon.

## Open Canvas Parent App Settings



In the Settings menu, tap the **Canvas Parent** link.

## Reset Cache on Next Launch



Locate **Canvas Parent Settings** [1]. Then tap the **Reset Cache on Next Launch** button [2].

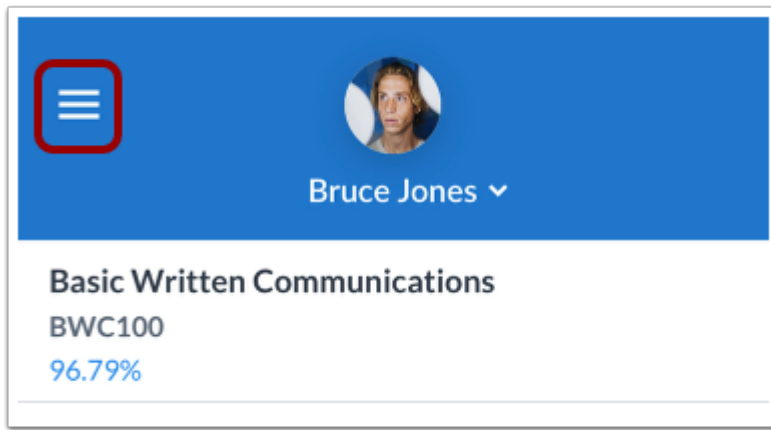
### Notes:

- After enabling the Reset Cache on Next Launch option, you must force close and relaunch the Parent app for your cache to reset.
- The Reset Cache on Next Launch button will toggle to the Off position after the cache has reset.

## How do I get help with the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device?

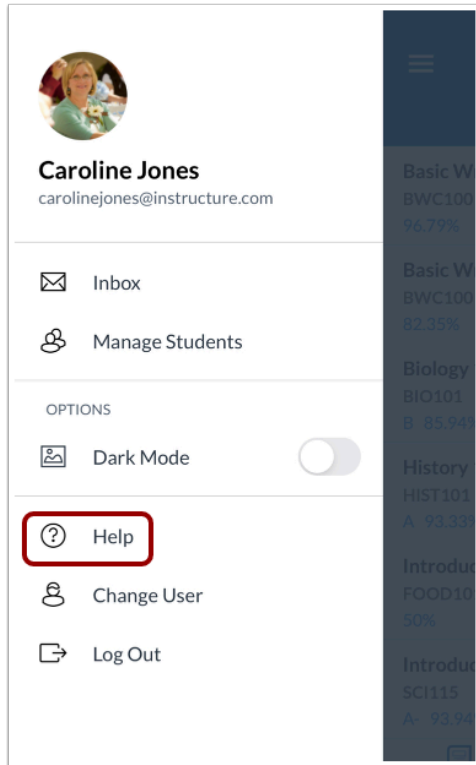
From the Help Menu, you can get help with Canvas directly on your mobile device. Help Menu links may vary across institutions.

Tap the **Menu** icon.

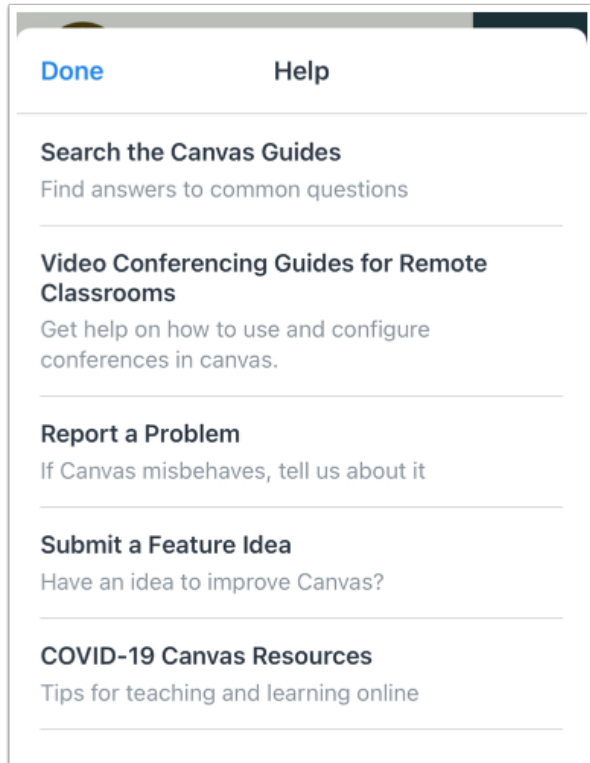
## Open Help

View the Help links provided to you. Available links may vary according to institution.

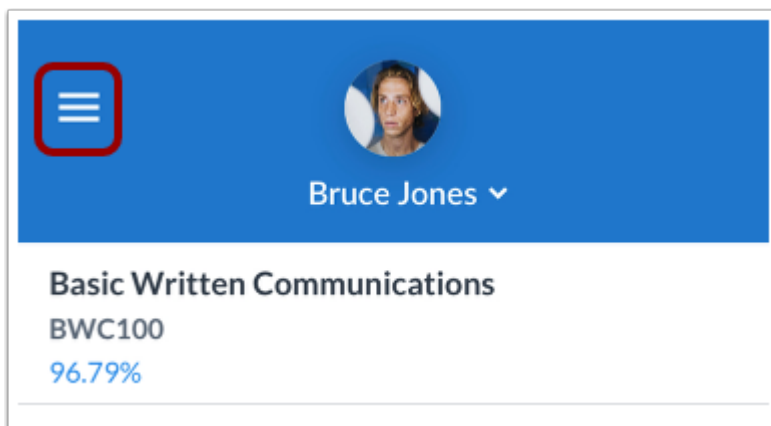


## How do I switch to another account in the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device?

If you use Canvas in more than one account (Canvas URL), you can change between accounts on your device without having to log out of the app.

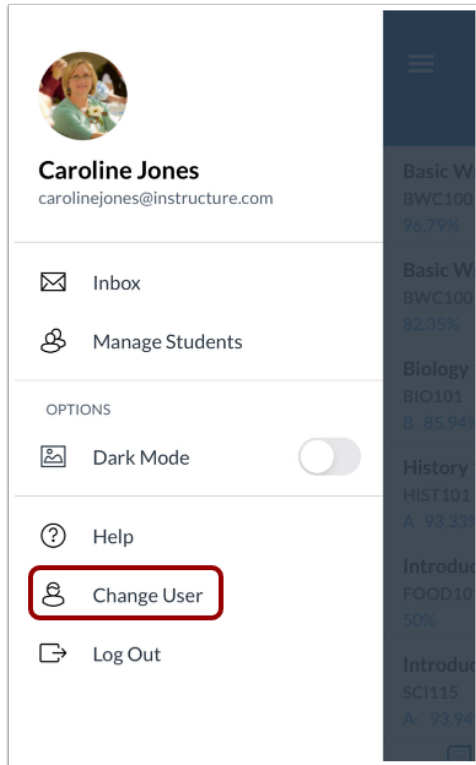

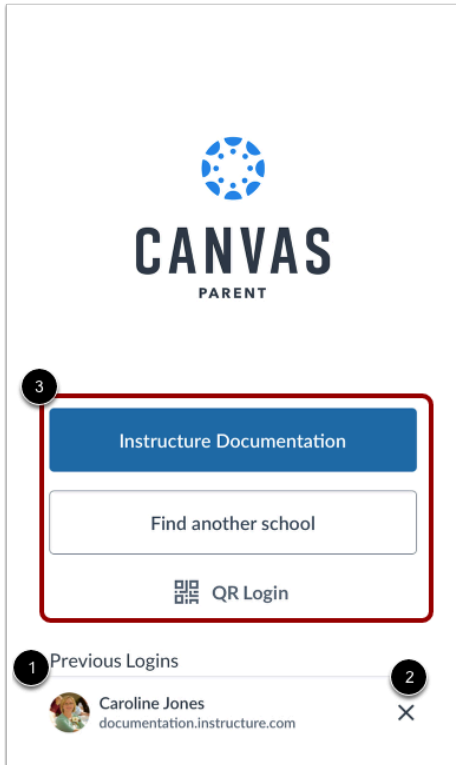

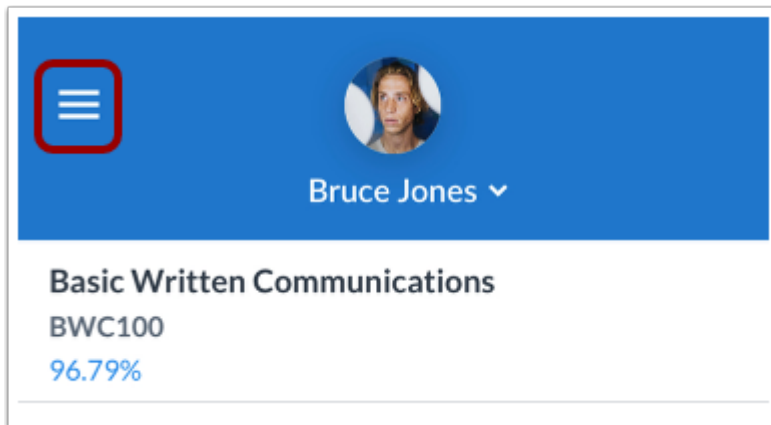

## How do I log out of the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device?

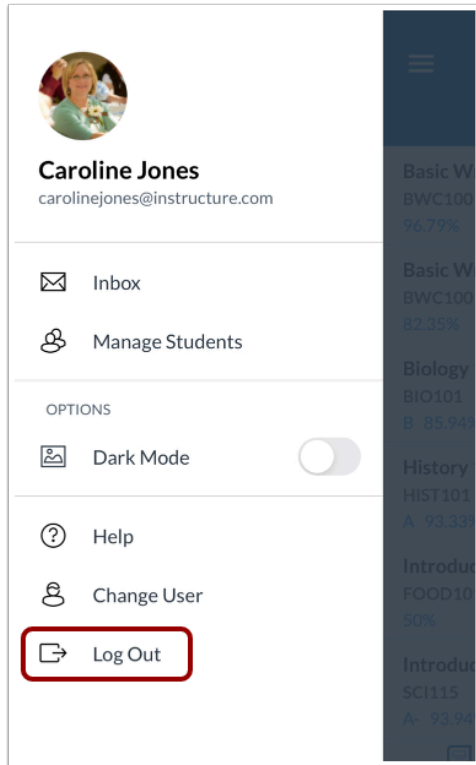
You can easily log out of Canvas Parent when you are finished using the app.

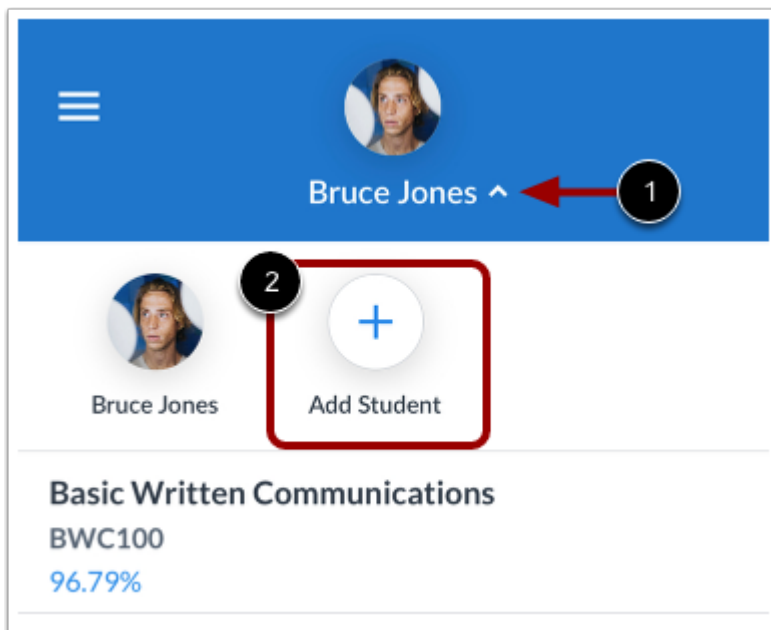
## How do I link additional students to my account in the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device?

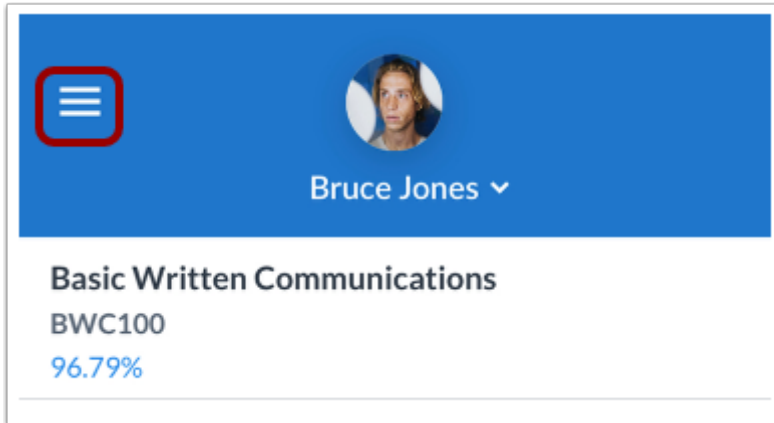

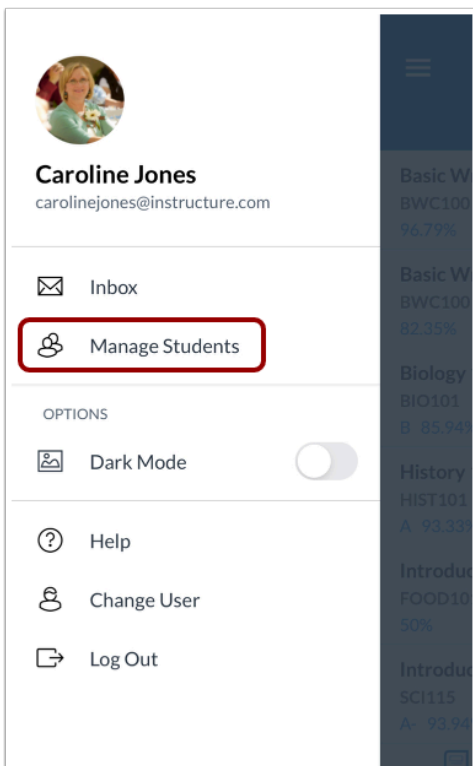
To link a student from the Student Selector, tap the **Student Selector** [1]. Then tap the **Add Student** icon [2].

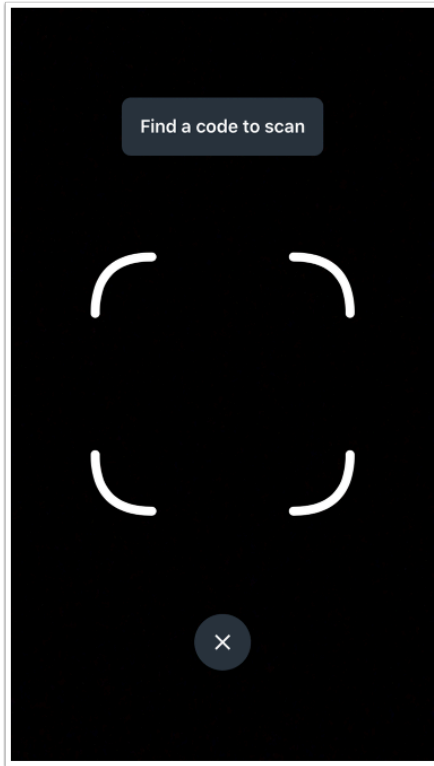

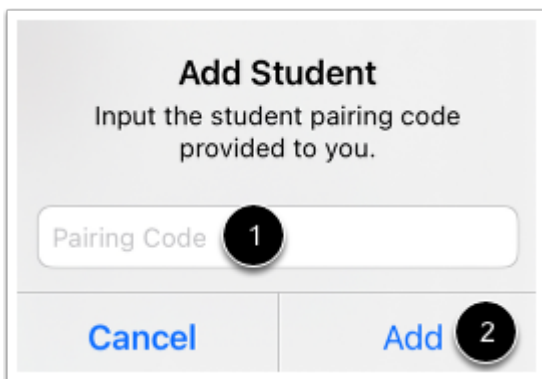

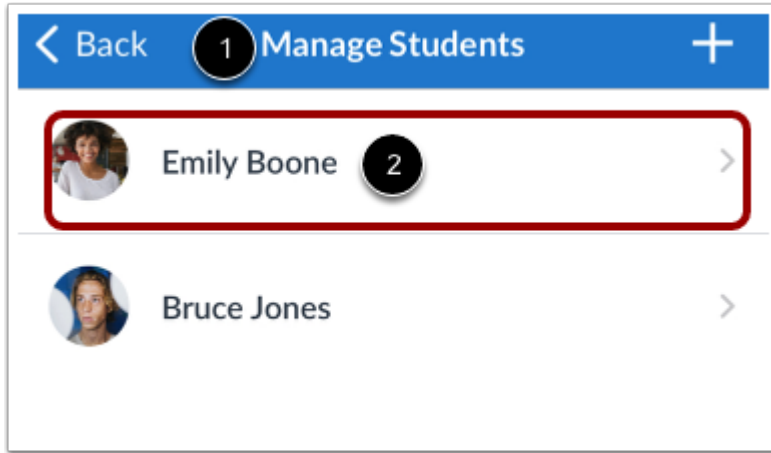

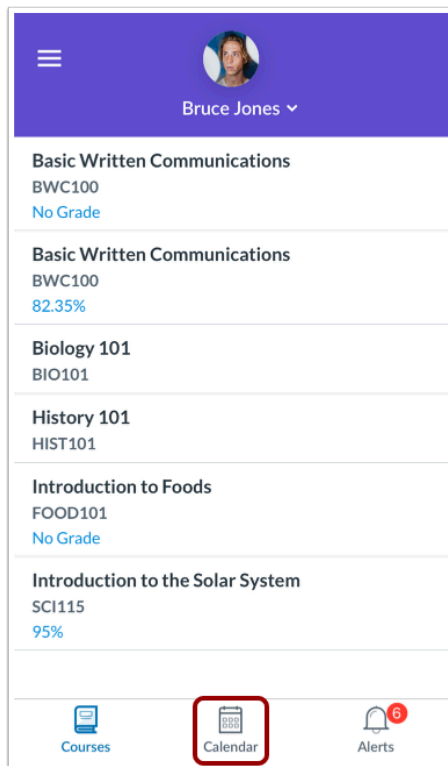

## How do I view the calendar of events and assignments for a student in the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device?

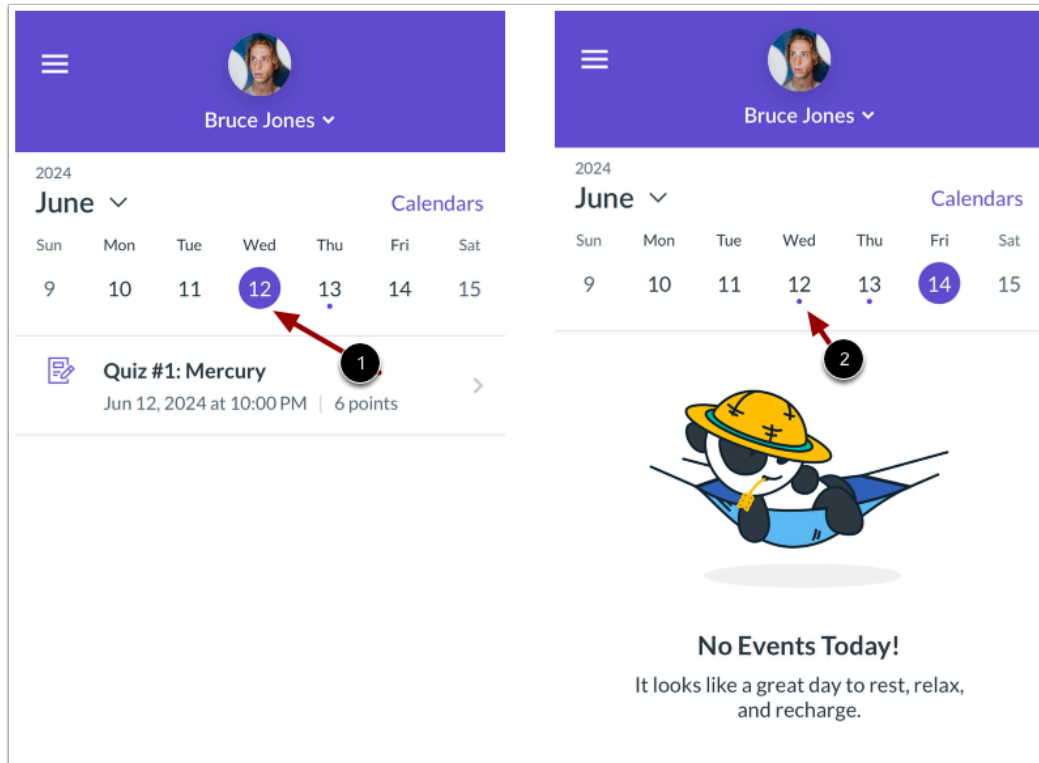
The Calendar page displays a calendar of assignments and events for the student(s) you are observing.

In the Dashboard, tap the **Calendar** icon.

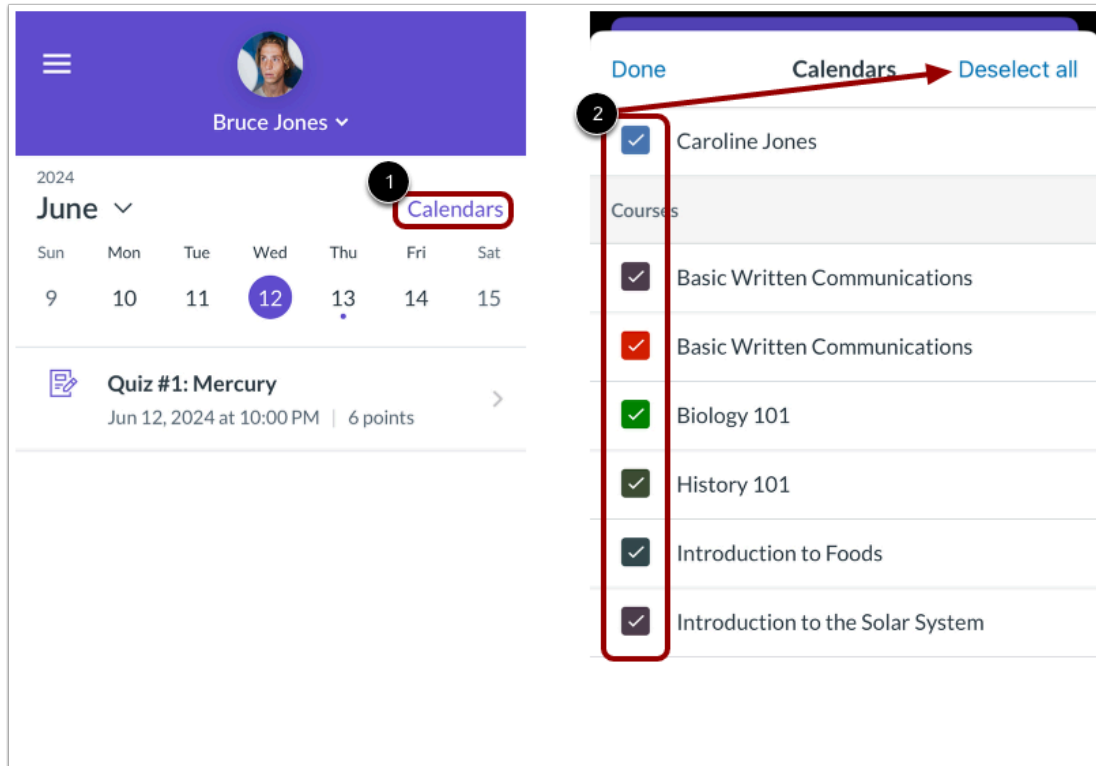
## View Calendar



The Calendar page shows all assignments and events for all the student's courses. By default, the calendar displays assignments and events by week. The current date is always selected and indicated by the solid background [1]. Any assignments or events on the current date display below the calendar in an agenda format.

Assignments or events on other dates are indicated by a dot below the date. Multiple dots indicate multiple assignments or events, which can be viewed by tapping the date [2].

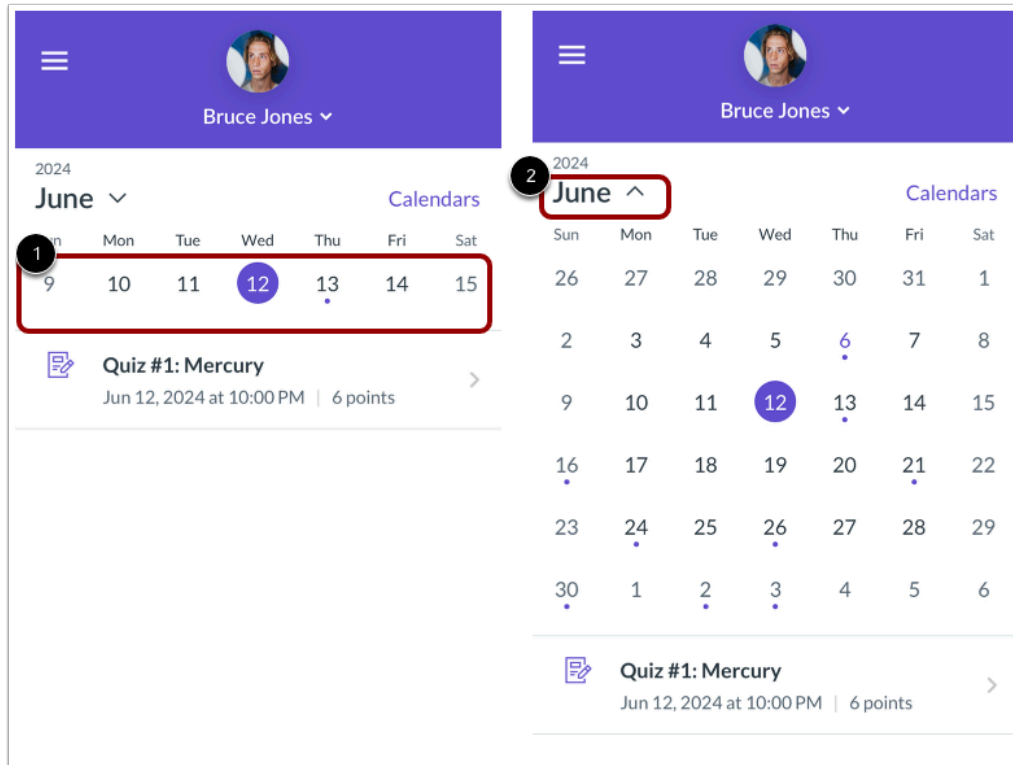
## Manage Calendars



You can manage the courses that display in the calendar by clicking the **Calendars** link [1].

You can select specific calendars or deselect all calendars [2].

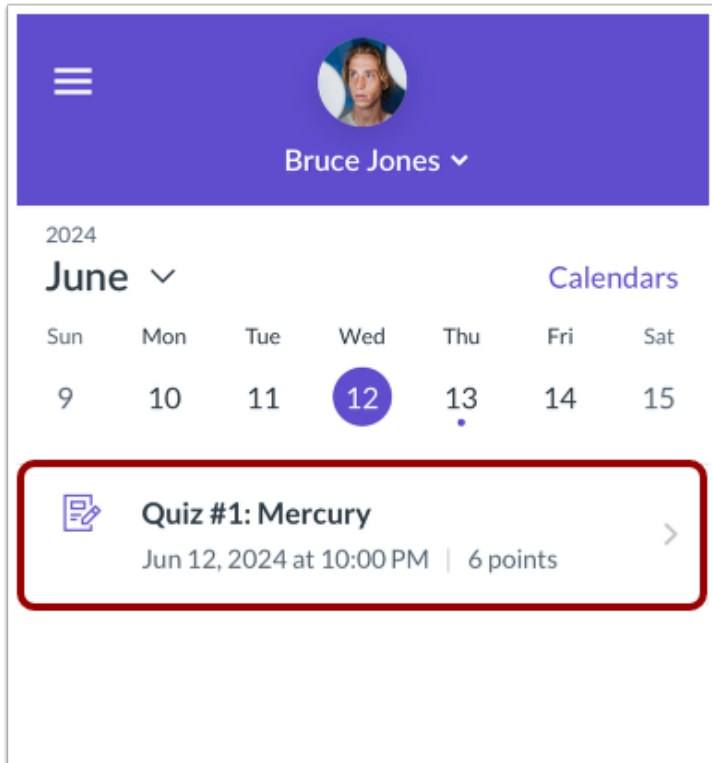
## View Additional Dates



To view assignments and events for other dates, swipe the week view left or right [1].

You can also expand to the calendar Month view by tapping the name of the month [2] and swiping the month view left or right.

## View Individual Event or Assignment



To view the [details of an individual assignment or event](#), tap the name of the assignment or event.

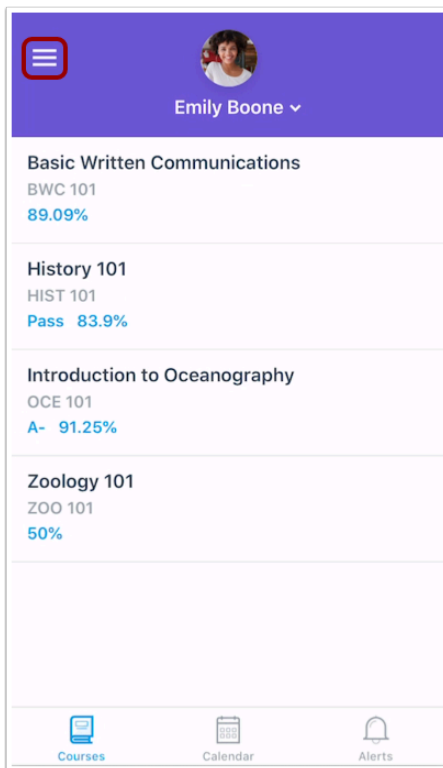


## How do I view my Canvas Inbox in the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device?

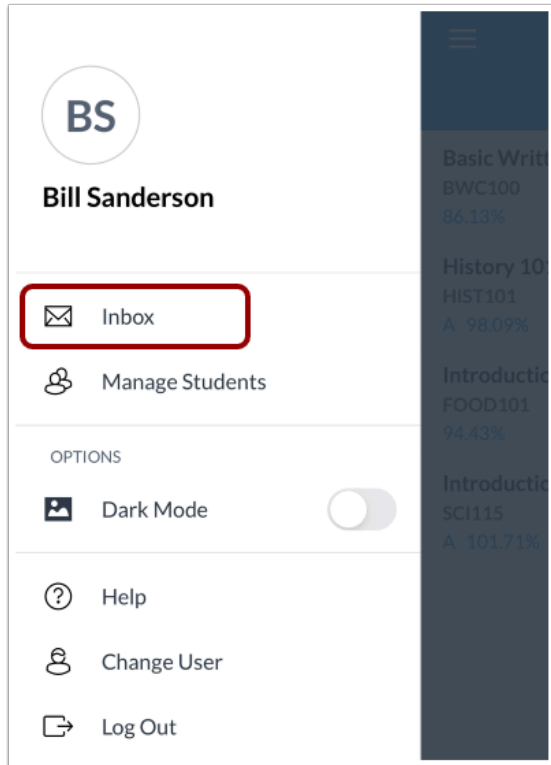

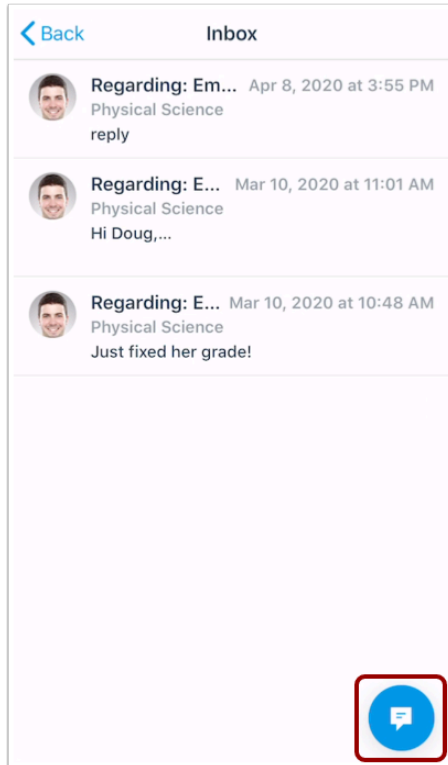

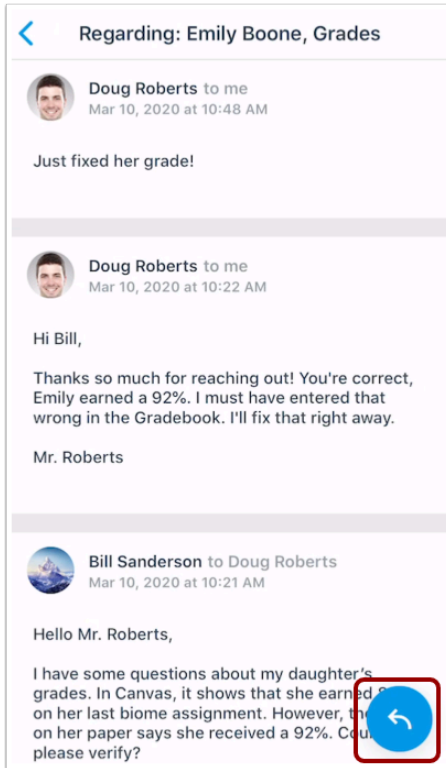

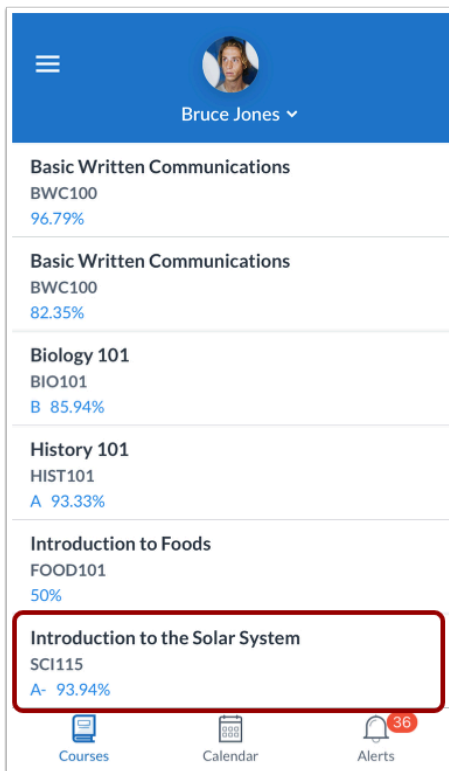

## How do I create a reminder for an assignment or event in the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device?

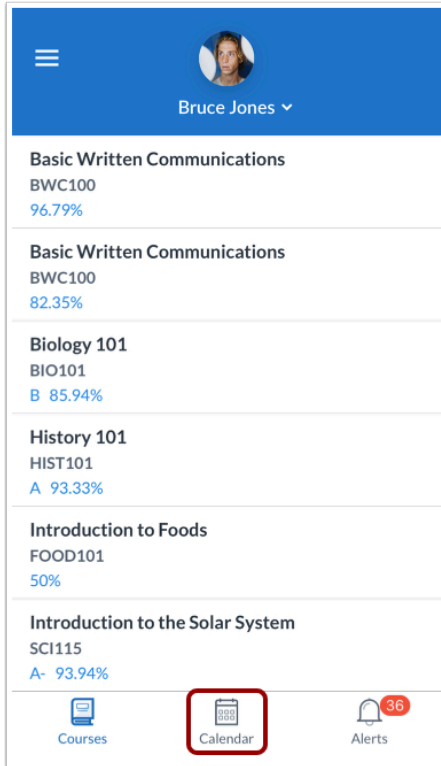
You can set reminders through the Courses page or the Calendar page. You can choose the date and time that you would like to receive the reminder. Reminders are sent as push notifications to your device.

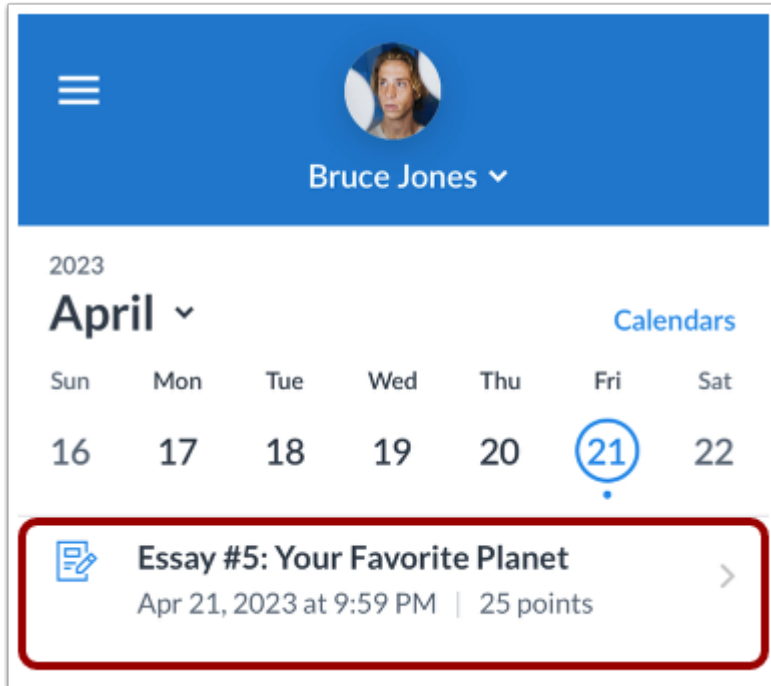



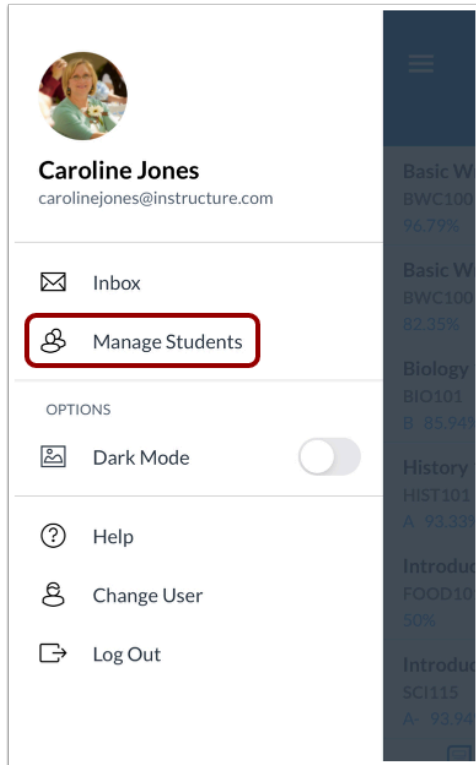

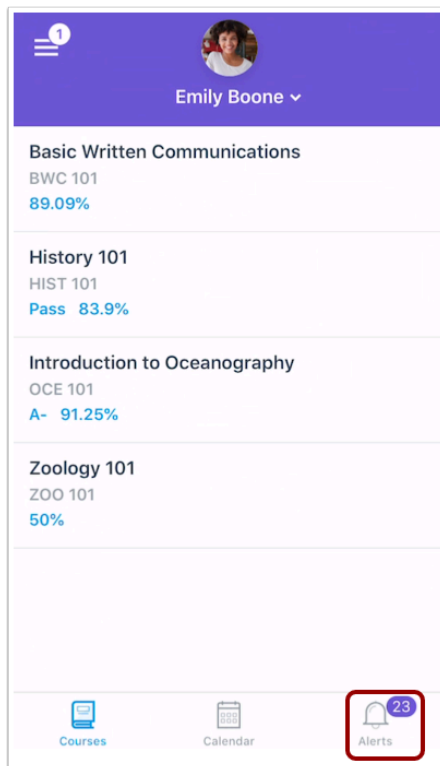
To enter a percentage alert, tap the numbers on the keypad [1]. To delete a digit, tap the **Delete** icon [2].

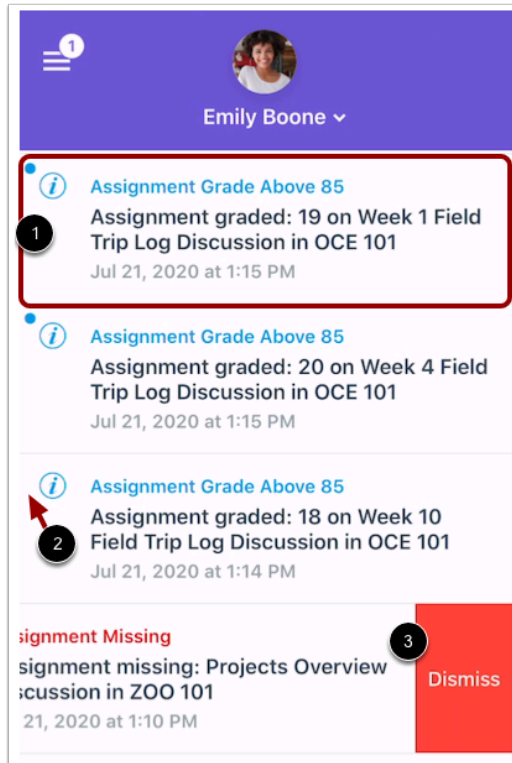

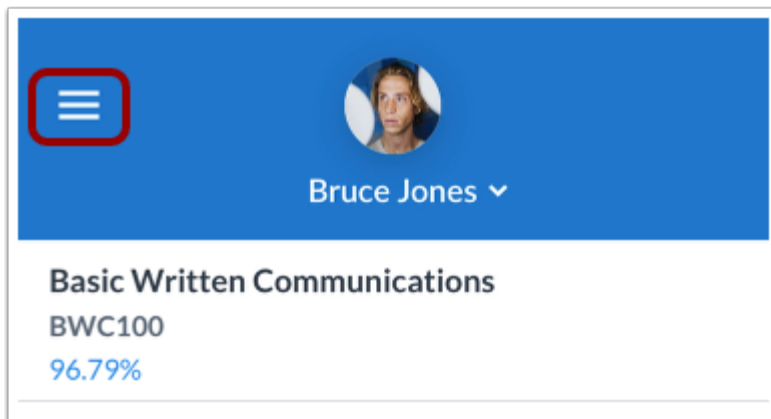

## How do I set my theme in the Parent App on my iOS device?

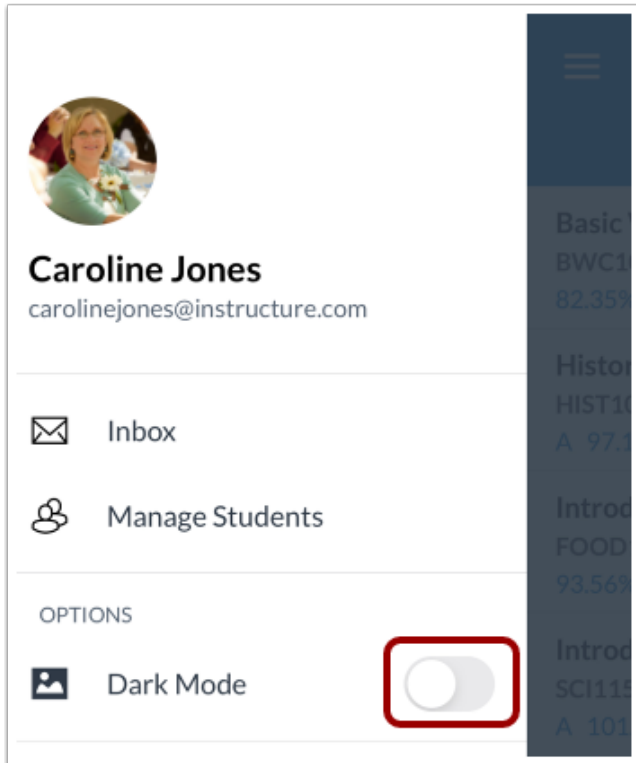
In Settings, parents can choose between three app theme options, Light, and Dark Mode.

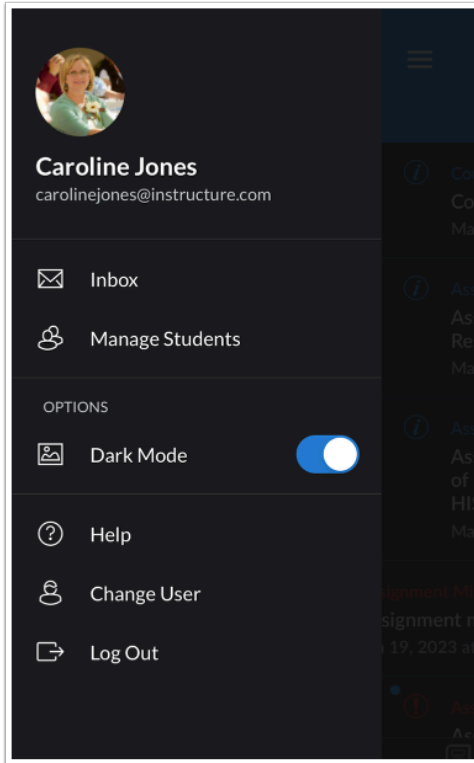

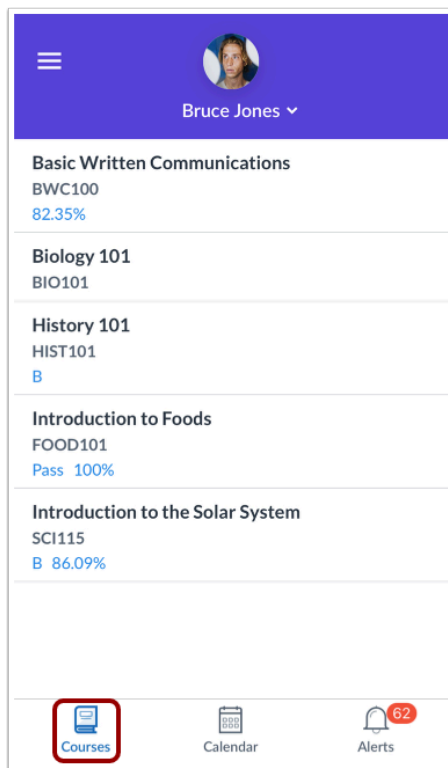
## How do I view courses for a student in the Canvas Parent app on my iOS device?

### Notes:

- When the course grade is set to display as a letter grade and quantitative data is allowed, the grade percentage also displays.
- If restricted by your student's instructor, you may only have the ability to view qualitative data, such as letter grades and grading comments.

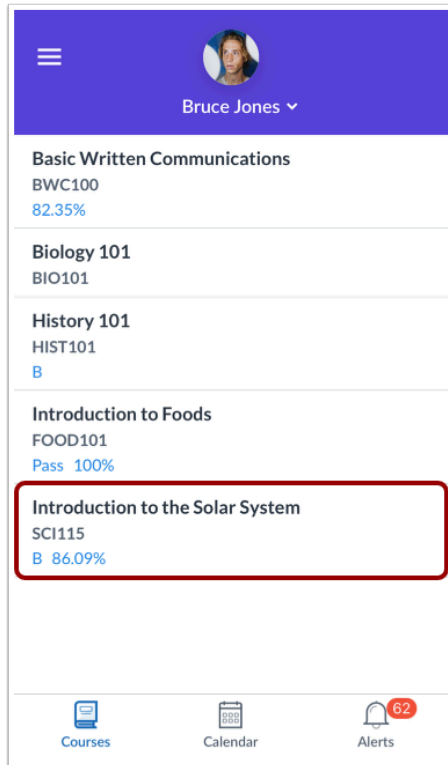



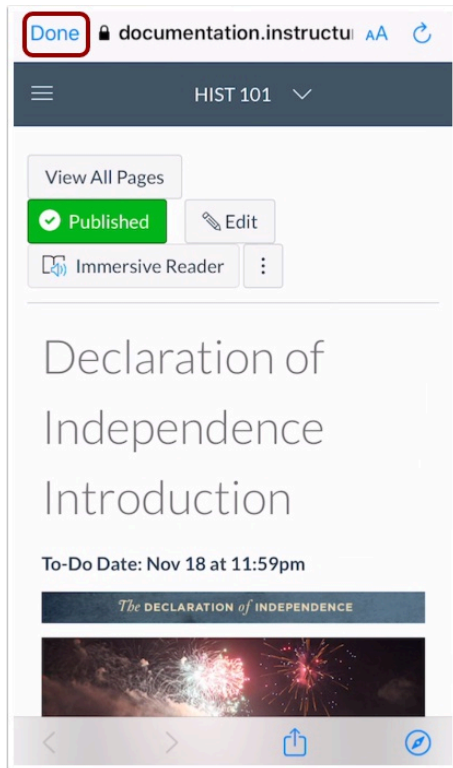

## How do I act as a user in the Parent app on my iOS device as an admin?

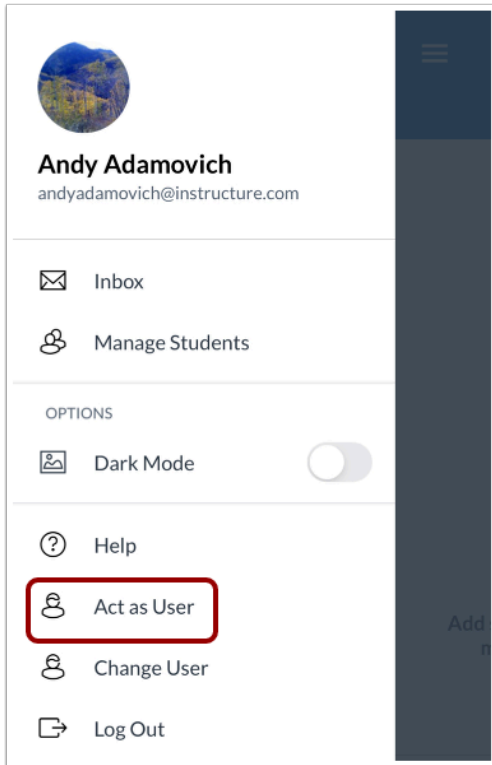
If you are an admin, you can act as a user in the Parent app and take any action in the app as if you were the observer. Only account-level users with the Act as users account permission can act as other users. This permission does not apply to sub-account admins.



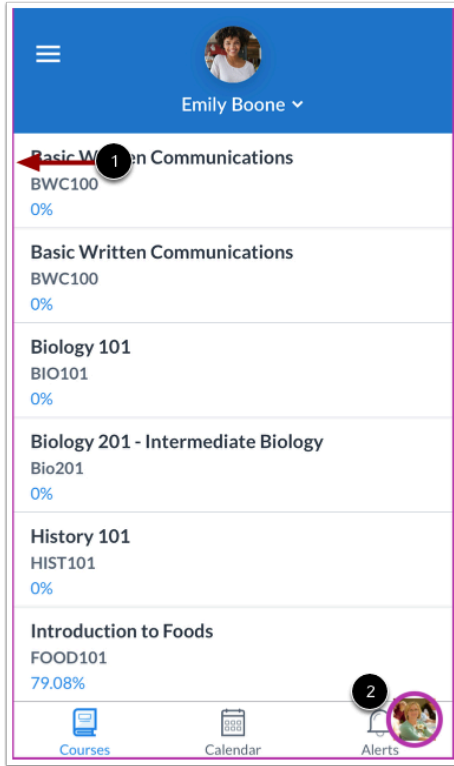

In the **User ID** field [1], enter the Canvas ID for the user. The domain will already be populated for you [2]. Then tap the **Act as User** button [3].

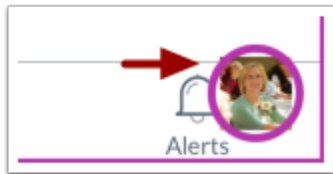

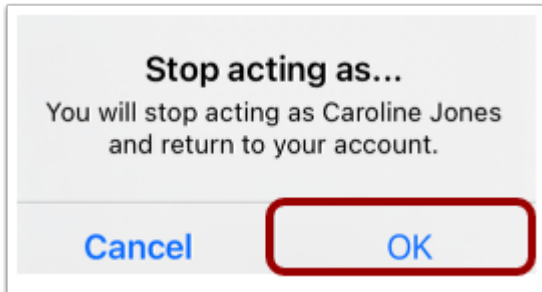
View the Parent app as the user. A colored border [1] and the user's **Profile** icon displays on every page while you are acting as the user [2].
